## 2012 Lottery Scholarship SB 49

### CAPE's Position:

This bill will only help a few students a year. If we are going to solve a problem, let's SOLVE A *REAL* PROBLEM, discrimination against homeschoolers!

Instead of legislating on behalf of a very few foreign exchange students or those home schooled students using expensive accredited high school programs, let's allow *anyone* who qualifies based on state residency, college admission, and first semester grades to qualify for the lottery scholarship. If the high school program is accredited (or not) isn't relevant when the scholarship is based on first semester grades. Whether the diploma came from an elite expensive private high school, a cobbled together high school program with a shoestring budget designed by a dedicated homeschooling mom, or a public high school diploma--if they have the college test scores to gain entrance, and the first semester grades, why are we discriminating?
