



2018 NM Christian Homeschool Convention Information & Policies

READ THE FINE PRINT! Many of the following details apply to everyone. A careful reading will clarify the registration process and make the convention much more enjoyable. Please, read the fine print! Some things change every year...like our kids!

DISCOUNTS AND DEADLINES Preregistrations save \$15 off the door price. Paid CAPE-NM members receive an additional \$10 discount off a couple's registration. Whether you are a new or current member, please take advantage of this discount. You may also join CAPE with your registration and take the discount. **EXCEPTION:** If the couple registration fee has been comped for any reason, the discount does not apply. Only one family per registration form. Only immediate family members (child or grandparent) qualify for additional person registration.

Confirmation packets will be posted on the CAPE-NM website (cape-nm.org) after March 30th. These will include a convention schedule, map/parking information, etc. **DO NOT MAIL REGISTRATIONS AFTER April 1st.** After this date, please register on site.

CANCELLATION POLICY All refund requests must be received in writing. Please mail requests to CAPE Registration, 16 Sunny Dale Rd., Edgewood, NM 87015 or email heckendorn@cape-nm.org. All refunds made before April 1st will be subject to a \$5.00 cancellation fee. Only 50% of the registration fee will be refunded after April 1st. No refunds will be made after April 16th.

SCHOLARSHIPS We offer full or partial scholarships to families who are in need of financial assistance. Please email registration@cape-nm.org to receive a scholarship application.

VOLUNTEERS We need your help. The CAPE-NM Convention is planned and run entirely by volunteers from across NM. If you can help either before or during the convention, please feel free to email volunteers@cape-nm.org, and you will be contacted. We always need help setting up on Thursday morning and tearing down on Saturday afternoon.

PUBLICITY We need your help to tell other parents about this conference. For a press release for your local newspaper, contact publicity@cape-nm.org.

CONVENTION CHAIR FAMILIES are all volunteers who serve by sacrificing time and energy to plan, organize, and produce the annual convention. It takes every member of the family to pitch in and get the job done, so we try to honor the whole family with this title. Part of the job is to recruit apprentice families to come alongside and train; so if you are interested, speak up!

PRE-CONVENTION EXHIBIT HALL The exhibit hall will be open Thursday at 1:30 PM as a special thank-you for our pre-registered CAPE members only. Name tag pickup will begin at 1:00 PM for pre-registered attendees. From 2:00 PM to 6:00 PM the exhibit hall will be open to all convention registrants for pre-convention shopping. The registration table will be open Thursday afternoon and evening beginning at 1:30 PM. Due to space constraints, no children under age 11 may accompany parents to the exhibit hall or elsewhere in the convention. Dependent nursing babies are the only exception. **ONLY** paid registered convention attendees are admitted to the exhibit hall! We respectfully ask that you abide by these rules without grumbling!

CHILDREN and YOUTH The conference is designed for parent/teacher enrichment. We do not allow children under 11 years of age into the convention or exhibit hall. There will be a children's program provided by LKidz Legacy Church Ministry that coincides with the convention. You may register your children when you register for the convention at www.legacychurch.com/children. Details on page 14.

Dependent nursing babies will be admitted free. Remember that sessions are being recorded; sit near an exit, and please step out if your baby becomes noisy. There are enthusiastic baby-walkers among our volunteer staff, so if you would like a brief break, ask your workshop host or hostess to arrange it.

Since homeschooling families are known for their togetherness, children 11 years and older may register as adults and attend with their parents. We include a few workshops of special interest to the younger people attending, but our focus is serving parent educators. Please do not leave any children unattended at any time inside or outside the convention premises.

USED CURRICULUM The very popular Used Curriculum Sale will be THURSDAY afternoon this year. Sellers' registrations must be postmarked by March 25. Please mark the box on the registration form. CAPE will supply the table for the sale. The seller's fee is \$25 which includes the cost of the table. No late entries will be accepted. Only registered convention attendees will be able to buy or sell used curriculum.

DIRECTIONS The 2018 Convention will be at Legacy Church of Albuquerque, 7201 Central Ave. NW. Legacy is located on the north side of Central.

Coming from I-40 (exit south)

Take the Unser or Coors exit and continue until you reach Central. From Unser turn east; from Coors turn west.

Coming from I-25

Take I-40 West then follow I-40 directions.

AUDIO RECORDING The general sessions and many of the workshops will be recorded. CDs will be available at the convention for \$6.00 each and most may be ordered later from CAPE-NM.

EVALUATIONS will be entered into a drawing for a free family registration in 2019. Please take the time to complete an evaluation; they help us to serve you. Forms can be found in the back of the convention program. Please drop off evaluations at the CAPE table or the registration table.

LODGING Be sure to make reservations early if you plan to stay at a local hotel; rate information is on page 16. Remember, rooms get booked quickly. Free lodging may be available through Bed & Breakfast host families; contact registration@cape-nm.org.

COMPANY MANNERS Some church ministries continue at Legacy during our conference while we are sharing the facility. Please respect all parking and office signs and cheerfully cooperate with our security volunteers. We want to be fondly remembered and, hopefully, welcomed back. Let a volunteer know if any area of the facility needs attention.

GRACE Homeschoolers are a particularly diverse group. Our speakers and our attendees are asked to remember to extend grace—whether the difference is in appearance, practice, opinion, or doctrine. FOOD A map of area restaurants will be included in the program. BEGINNERS Parents considering home education are encouraged to attend the free Getting Started Workshop on Thursday afternoon. The workshop runs from 12:30 PM to 3:30 PM.

WORKSHOPS If you are new to homeschooling or jumped in without a lot of preparation, there is a special series of workshops we have designed especially for YOU! Read through the descriptions (available on site in the convention program) and choose the ones that are appealing to you. If another workshop interests you, please feel free to attend. Complete workshop descriptions will also be published in our spring magazine for members only.

RIBBONS Volunteers, speakers, graduates, and honored guests are identified with special ribbons. A key will be published in the program. Grandparents are encouraged to stop at the CAPE registration table and receive their recognition ribbons.

HONORED GUESTS Elected and appointed officials, candidates for office, and reporters may be invited to attend as guests of the convention. They are welcome to observe and to learn more about home education and home educators. Please extend our invitation and contact Registration with information so name badges can be prepared.

SCHEDULES Every moment of the convention is action-packed! The time and the facility are filled to overflowing with opportunities for learning, fellowshiping, shopping, and sharing. We encourage you to take advantage of every opportunity; we also encourage you to schedule time to reflect, to eat, and to rest! You may have to choose between a quick snack and a sit-down dinner in order to have time for everything. Choose wisely, according to your needs and priorities.
