


12 OPTIMAL WAYS TO TRIGGER THE BRAIN

5. Schedule active vs. passive periods
6. Teach or learn tough subjects during high voltage times
7. Use small moments wisely

Four more winning strategies:

8. Teach for whole body instruction
9. Use an analogy or object lesson whenever possible
10. Drive a new concept into inner speech
11. Sink an emotional hook in first, then follow with the facts
12. Get another angle for no-takes
