

2024 NM Homeschool Convention Information & Policies

<u>ADVERTISING</u> If you have a business you would like to promote to homeschool families, contact CAPE advertising at <u>advertise@cape-nm.org</u>. <u>AUDIO RECORDING</u> The general sessions and many of the workshops will be recorded. Downloads of the sessions may be purchased at the convention. Recordings of recent and past conventions are available for purchase on the CAPE website at https://www.cape-nm.org/shop/.

<u>CANCELLATION POLICY</u> All refund requests must be received in writing. Please mail requests to CAPE Registration, P.O. Box 1506 Moriarty, NM 87035 or email <u>registration@cape-nm.org</u>. All refunds made before June 1st will be subject to a \$5 cancellation fee. Only 50% of the registration will be refunded between June 1st and June 6th. No refunds will be made after June 7th.

<u>CHILDREN and YOUTH</u> The conference is designed for parent/teacher enrichment. If you have young children, we ask that you sit at the rear of the workshop, out of consideration for others and for recording purposes. Noises that precious children make can sometimes interfere with the recording. An age-appropriate program for children is provided by LKidz Legacy Church Ministry that coincides with the convention. You may register your children when you register for the convention at <u>www.cape-nm.org</u>.

We include a few workshops of special interest to the younger people attending, but our focus is serving parent educators. Please do not leave any children under the age of 10 unattended at any time inside or outside the convention premises, including the exhibit hall.

<u>DISCOUNTS</u> Early Bird registrations save \$15 off the final registration price. Paid CAPE-NM members receive an additional \$40 discount off a couple's registration. Only one family per registration form. Only immediate family members (child or grandparent) qualify for additional person registration.

FOOD Many families come prepared with their own meals, which can be enjoyed as a picnic (weather permitting) with other homeschool families during the lunch or dinner hour. Legacy does allow food and drink in the main foyer, and there are places available to bring your picnic indoors. Only water bottles are allowed in carpeted areas. There are many restaurants available within the area.
